PROACTIVELY MANAGE RISKS FOR BUSINESS ADVANTAGE

All projects face some level of risk. Those who know how to identify risks and handle them effectively can use those risks to realize business advantage. The key is to be proactive by identifying risks early in the project life cycle and taking action to prevent those becoming problems, while investing minimum effort and cost to do so. This workshop enables participants to use industry best practices to build an effective standard risk management approach for their projects.

Description:

The Project Risk Management Workshop is ideal for practitioners at various levels of the organization, those dealing with risk on a specific project, as well as those developing risk management processes for their organization to use on various types of projects.

Workshop instructors leverage industry best practices, including those from the ISO standard on risk management, the Project Management Body of Knowledge (PMBOK®) and Capability Maturity Model® Integration for Development (CMMI-DEV) or for Acquisition (CMMI-ACQ). Participants use risk factor tables and example process assets provided with the workshop to develop a useful risk management approach for their organization or project.

In guided project-based learning sessions, participants tailor an approach for risk management, use a risk factor table and local resources for risk identification, document specific risks clearly, rate and rank project risks, develop a risk management plan, and create risk tracking charts and reports of key risks.
